History

Ken Henry was a known scratch builder from the Baltimore area. He built approximately 100 locomotives, of various prototypes. His very early pieces used components from All Nation, and were relatively basic in terms of detail. His later pieces, exhibited well done rivet patterns, additional detail, and representative paint schemes. The models listed here are representative of Ken Henry's later pieces. The characteristics of these models include open frame motors and open or enclosed gear boxes. All of his models ran well. What most impresses me about his models are how accurate the boilers are, how well each model represents the prototype, and the overall presentation of the construction and finish. His detail work on his later pieces is also very impressive. The bottom line is his models look like the prototypes.

For these Ken Henry pieces, we do not modify them, but just restore them to how they were originally built and to ensure they are running properly.
